WITHDRAWAL POLICY:

REGISTRAR'S OFFICE: A student must withdraw from a class or from the college according to catalog procedures. Failure to withdraw officially will result in failing grades and forfeiture of any possible refund. See Registrar for details.

FINANCIAL AID: Financial Aid Recipients must see the Financial Aid Office prior to withdrawal from a class or the College.

BUSINESS OFFICE: All students must see the Business Office prior to withdrawal from a class or the College. A student who withdraws with an account balance has the right to appeal the balance. The Business Office will provide information on the appeal process.

The College reserves the right to cancel any course for which there is insufficient enrollment or other factors beyond the control of the College. Full refund will be granted for cancelled courses. The College reserves the right to alter specific class schedules due to unforeseen

events or emergencies. The College reserves the right to revise its tuition and fees whenever it becomes necessary to do so.

PAYMENT POLICY

Questions regarding a student's account balance are to be directed to the Student Account Representative-Business Office; questions regarding a student's financial aid are to be directed to the Student Account Representative – Financial Aid.

Plan I: Payment of the account in full by January 9th.

Plan II: FACTS Tuition Management. Student pays 25% of the outstanding balance by January 9th, 3 equal payments due February 9th, March 9th and April 9th which are automatically deducted from a savings or checking account. A student having approved loans, grants or scholarships may deduct these amounts. A service charge of \$25 will be assessed by FACTS at the time arrangements are made. A student utilizing this plan must complete the paperwork no later than 3 weeks prior to the beginning of each semester. Forms are available from the Student Account Representative-Business Office.

Plan III: Student pays to SCC 25% of the outstanding balance by January 9th, 3 equal payments due February 9th, March 9th and April 9th. A student having approved loans, grants or scholarships may deduct these amounts. A carrying fee of \$50 will be added to the account. Interest may be applied by SCC on accounts in arrears. In the event the student cannot make his/her scheduled payment he/she is to contact the Student Account Representative-Business Office.

Employer Reimbursement: Students who are reimbursed by employers for college expenses must follow either Plan I or Plan II or Plan III. For students whose employers reimburse SCC directly, at the end of the semester, there is a \$50.00 carrying charge. To avoid interest charges documentation must be provided within 30 days of the beginning of the semester.

3rd Party Payments: Students whose accounts will be paid by a 3rd party, ie, VA, Voc Rehab, etc. to avoid interest charges the student must provide documentation within 30 days of the beginning of the semester.

International Students: Students from foreign countries are required to make payment in full by money order, credit card or by check payable through a United States Bank before arriving at SCC. No student will be allowed to move into the residence halls without making payment in full.

Delinquent Accounts: Students who fail to set up a payment plan or complete their financial aid within 30 days of the beginning of each semester will be charged a \$50 carrying fee and interest charges. The College reserves the right to withdraw a student from classes and the residence hall. New registration will not be accepted until accounts are cleared. Transcripts of credit, degrees or recommendations will not be issued for a student whose account has a balance due.
